

We remind you that **the entrance to the Event will be carried out exclusively by the QR code** confirming: vaccination, negative PCR test, valid within 48 hours from the moment of collection of biological material, or an illness transferred over the last 180 days, with the presentation of an identity document (passport).

It will be impossible to go to the Event without a valid QR code, even if there is a negative PCR test that is not confirmed by the QR code, a certificate of antibodies, or a paper certificate of vaccination will be impossible.

Delivery of the PCR test at the Event is not carried out.

For citizens of the Russian Federation:

The QR code can be obtained in the electronic medical record, on mos.ru, on emias.info and on the portal "State services. Stop coronavirus." The QR code is issued automatically:

1. If you have passed the PCR test in an organization connected to the UMIAS system. The QR code based on the test is valid for 48 hours from the moment of collection of biological material.

If you received a test result, but did not receive a QR code, call the laboratory or clinic where you took the test, check your passport data and ask to re-send them to the UMIAS system.

2. If you have been vaccinated. **The QR code is issued only after complete vaccination.**

If you were vaccinated with the first component of a two-component vaccine, you will need to pass a PCR test to enter the Event.

If you have received a full vaccination, but there is no QR code, you must visit the clinic where you were vaccinated or to which you are attached, and request the QR code directly from the registry.

3. If you have been ill in the last 180 days. A QR code is issued to those who have an official confirmation of a past illness - that is, they have consulted a doctor, had a smear and are listed in the regional or federal register of those who have been ill. You cannot get a QR code from the antibody certificate.

For citizens of foreign countries:

1. To receive a QR code, you need to register on the mos.ru website (simple account), which requires a mobile phone number and e-mail.

2. It is necessary to pass a PCR test in an organization connected to the UMIAS system. The QR code based on the test is valid for 48 hours from the moment of collection of biological material.

If you received a test result, but did not receive an SMS notification about the formation of a QR code, call the laboratory or clinic where you took the test, check your data and ask to re-send them to the UMIAS system.
